visit hospitals in Houston where the  
ladies met with already established  
auxiliaries. Much information was  
gathered from these trips.

However, it wasn't until 1960 that the  
auxiliary was formed under the urging  
of Mrs. Helen Cowart and Mrs. Rose  
Cannon. The first recorded minutes of  
the organization were taken at a meeting  
on December 5, 1960 in the Service  
Center at 9:30am. Presiding Officer,  
Mrs. Helen Cowart. Officers were  
elected.

The auxiliary constitution was written  
and approved by the Hospital Board.  
The local auxiliary is affiliated with the  
Texas Association of Healthcare  
Volunteers. The charter membership was  
a total of 81 persons.
