

NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$0.28995 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Matagorda County Hospital District.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.28995 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.29205 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.30367 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2022 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Matagorda County Hospital District from the same properties in both the 2021 tax year and the 2022 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Matagorda County Hospital District may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Matagorda County Hospital District is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2022 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 14, 2022 AT Noon AT Matagorda Regional Medical Center, Conference Room A, 104 7th Street, Bay City, Texas 77414..

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Matagorda County Hospital District is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the of Matagorda County Hospital District at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by Matagorda County Hospital District last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by Matagorda County Hospital District this year.

Total tax levy on all properties	\$16,995,123	\$16,895,294	decrease of -99,829, or -0.59%
