

MATAGORDA COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT NOTICE OF MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Managers of Matagorda County Hospital District will hold a public meeting on Tuesday, March 28, 2023 at 5:30pm in Conference Room A at Matagorda Regional Medical Center, 104 7th Street, Bay City, Texas for the approval of a Chapter 312 ad valorem property tax abatement and Payment In Lieu of Tax (PILOT) agreement with PCC Chemicals Corp (Project Opera). Exhibit A provides a project summary and Exhibits B & C includes information on the established Reinvestment Zone.

EXHIBIT A

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING ON TAX INCENTIVES CONSIDERED FOR PCC Chemicals Corp.

The Board of Managers of Matagorda County Hospital District will hold a public meeting regarding the approval of a tax abatement with PCC Chemicals Corp.

The meeting will take place on Tuesday, March 28, 2023 at 5:30pm in Conference Room A of Matagorda Regional Medical Center.

Details of the project are as follows:

Owner of property/Company: PCC Chemicals Corp.

Location of Reinvestment Zone: See Exhibits B & C

Summary of project:

The Company intends to invest approximately Four Hundred and Two Million, Five Hundred and Twenty-Four Thousand United States Dollars (\$402,524,000.00 USD) in the design, permitting, construction, and completion of an industrial-scale plant designed to produce alkoxylate and polyol chemicals, which will be located within the Zone. The Company's total anticipated capital investment includes, but is not limited to office buildings, industrial facilities, machinery and equipment, raw material and finished product tanks, utilities, infrastructure, and various real and personal property improvements related to the processing and/or operations activities of the Premises.

The Project is expected to create approximately One Hundred and Thirty-Four (134) new full time equivalent employee positions.

EXHIBIT B

Legal Description

Thirty (30) to sixty (60) acres of land more or less, located on the Port Authority's 99 acre tract at the Port of Bay City Terminal, the "option property") owned by the Port Authority with the sixty (60) acres being adjacent to and located east of the Sunoco Partners Marketing and Terminals, L.P. facility, and north of FM 3057 in Matagorda County, Texas, as described generally on Exhibit "C" under the name "Tract 1, 30 ac." and "Tract 2, 27 ac."

TRACT I 99.97 ACRES

BEING a 99.97 acre tract of land situated in the James Moore League, Abstract 62, Matagorda County, Texas, and being a portion of the remainder of that certain tract of land conveyed by Doris Ledwidge Fondren to Walter W. Fondren, III, et al according to instrument recorded in Volume 665, Page 753 of the Deed Records of said County, said 99.97 acre tract of land being more fully described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at a 5/8 inch diameter steel rebar set to mark the common corner of the remainder of said Fondren tract and that certain tract of land conveyed by F.A.S.H. Family Partnership to River Rice & Cattle Company according to instrument recorded in Volume 369, Page 925 of the Official Records of said County, in the northwest line of that certain tract of land described as 50.45 acres as conveyed by Walter W. Fondren, Jr. to Missouri Pacific Railroad Company according to instrument recorded in Volume 372, Page 503 of the Deed Records of said County, said rebar being South 87 deg. 07' 56" West, a distance of 154.76 feet from a 1-1/2 inch diameter steel rebar found marking the northwest corner of that certain tract of land described as 1000 acres as conveyed to Celanese Corporation of America according to instrument recorded in Volume 362, Page 16 of the Deed Records of said County;

THENCE, South 46 deg. 45' 14" West, along the common line of said 50.45 acre tract, a distance of 2163.41 feet (S 48 deg. 23' W per Vol. 372, Pg. 503) to a 5/8 inch diameter steel rebar set to mark the southeast corner of the tract herein described, in the north line of that certain tract of land conveyed as right of way by Doris Ledwidge Fondren to the State of Texas according to instrument recorded in Volume 452, Page 532 of the Deed Records of said County (a.k.a. F.M. 3057);

THENCE, South 69 deg. 06' 59" West, with the north line of said F.M. 3057, a distance of 398.64 feet (S 70 deg. 44' W per Vol. 452, Pg. 532) to a 5/8 inch diameter steel rebar set to mark an angle point;

THENCE, South 81 deg. 13' 59" West, with the north line of said F.M. 3057, a distance of 1660.29 feet (S 82 deg. 51', 1590.4' per Vol. 452, Pg. 532) to a 5/8 inch diameter steel rebar set to mark the southwest corner of the tract herein described, in the east line of that certain tract of land described as 180.83 acres as conveyed by Walter W. Fondren, Jr. to Matagorda County Navigation District No. 2 according to instrument recorded in Volume 3, Page 611 of the Deed Records of said County;

THENCE, North 02 deg. 58' 00" West (Basis of Bearing), along the common line of said 180.83 acre tract, at 1462.48 feet pass a 5/8 inch diameter steel rebar found, and continuing for an overall distance of 1686.82 feet (N 02 deg. 58' W per Vol. 3, Pg. 611) to a 5/8 inch diameter steel rebar found marking the common corner of the remainder of said Fondren tract and said 180.83 acre tract, in the south line of the aforesaid River Rice & Cattle Company tract, for the northwest corner of the tract herein described;

THENCE, North 86 deg. 59' 52" East, along the common line of said River Rice & Cattle Company tract, a distance of 3681.57 feet (N 88 deg. 31' 48" E per Vol. 369, Pg. 925) to the POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING within these metes and bounds a 99.97 acre tract of land, more or less.

TRACT II 20.64 ACRES

BEING a 20.64 acre tract of land situated in the James Moore League, Abstract 62, Matagorda County, Texas, and being a portion of the remainder of that certain tract of land conveyed by Doris Ledwidge Fondren to Walter W. Fondren, III, et al according to instrument recorded in Volume 665, Page 753 of the Deed Records of said County, said 20.64 acre tract of land being more fully described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at a 5/8 inch diameter steel rebar found marking the common corner of the remainder of said Fondren tract and that certain tract of land conveyed by Doris Ledwidge Fondren, et al to Pontiac Refining Corporation according to instrument recorded in Volume 448, Page 352 of the Deed Records of said County, in the south line of that certain tract of land conveyed as right of way by Doris Ledwidge Fondren to the State of Texas according to instrument recorded in Volume 452, Page 532 of the Deed Records of said County (a.k.a. F.M. 3057);

THENCE, South 46 deg. 50' 05" West, along the common line of said Pontiac Refining Corporation tract, a distance of 2037.03 feet (S 48 deg. 23' W per Vol. 665, Pg. 753) to a 5/8 inch diameter steel rebar found marking the common corner of said Fondren tract and said Pontiac Refining Corporation tract, in the east line of that certain tract of land described as 180.83 acres as conveyed by Walter W. Fondren, Jr. to Matagorda County Navigation District No. 2, according to instrument recorded in Volume 3, Page 611 of the Deed Records of said County, for the south corner of the tract herein described;

THENCE, North 02 deg. 58' 00" West (Basis of Bearing), along the common line of said 180.83 acre tract, a distance of 1156.33 feet (N 02 deg. 58' W per Vol. 3, Pg. 611) to a 5/8 inch diameter steel rebar set in the south line of said F.M. 3057, for the west corner of the tract herein described;

THENCE, North 81 deg. 13' 59" East, with the south line of said F.M. 3057, a distance of 1530.28 feet (N 82 deg. 51' E, 1623.2' per Vol. 452, Pg. 532) to a 5/8 inch diameter steel rebar set to mark the point of curvature of a curve to the left;

THENCE, along said curve to the left, radius = 1507.78 feet, interior angle = 1 deg. 16' 48", chord bears N 80 deg. 34' 02" E, 33.68 feet, for an arc length of 33.68 feet, to the POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING within these metes and bounds a 20.64 acre tract of land, more or less.






